Surface Preparation

Read the Lead Warning in Cautions section. Clean surface thoroughly. Remove dirt and grease by washing the surface with a non-residue all-purpose cleaner. Wash dirt from protected areas such as under eaves. Remove loose or peeling paint and rust with a wire brush and scraper. Dull glossy areas by sanding lightly. Caulk cracks and crevices around windows, doors and trim. Unpainted wood or weathered surfaces should be primed with a first coat of Valspar Latex Home & Ranch Paint thinned with one pint (16 fl. oz.) of water per gallon of paint. For metal trim, remove all loose paint, rust and scale before painting. Spot prime previously rusted areas with a rust inhibiting primer. Clean Mildew from the Surface: Mildew is a fungus that looks like dirt, but won't wash off. Mildew must be removed before finishing or it will grow through any new coating. To remove mildew, scrub with a commercial mildew remover or a solution of 1 part liquid chlorine bleach to 3 parts of water. Rinse thoroughly and allow to dry. Protect eyes and skin by wearing protective equipment including rubber gloves and eye goggles when working with bleach solution.

Application and Clean-up

Paint only when surface and air temperatures are above 50°F (10 °C). Stir paint thoroughly before and occasionally during painting. Do not paint in damn weather or when rain is threatening. Apply paint with premium quality brush, roller or by airless spray. Start painting at the highest point and work from left to right. Brush paint well into surface. Always finish at a door, window or outer edge. Do not stop painting in the middle of an open space. Thin sparingly, if necessary, with water. Clean brushes, rollers, equipment and hands with warm soapy water.

If painting indoors, open windows and doors or use other means to ensure fresh air entry during application and drying.
